Worksheet Chart for Analysis Using Laban Movement Analysis:

Aspect	Observation	Reflection
Direction of Movement	What directions are the movements taking (e.g., forward, backward, sideways)?	How do these directions contribute to the overall meaning and feel of the dance?
Speed of Movement	Are the movements fast, slow, or a combination of both?	How does the speed of movement enhance the emotional impact or storytelling of the dance?
Weight of Movement	Are the movements light or heavy, sustained or sudden?	How does the weight of movement affect the viewer's perception of the dance?
Modern Elements	What modern techniques or elements did you notice in the dance?	How do these modern elements enhance the dance performance?
Traditional Elements	What traditional techniques or elements did you notice in the dance?	How do these traditional elements contribute to cultural authenticity?
Innovative Techniques	Identify any innovative techniques used in the dance.	How do these techniques push the boundaries of contemporary dance forms?
Cultural Diversity	What aspects of Southeast Asian culture were highlighted in the dance?	How do these aspects celebrate the rich cultural diversity of SEA countries?
Emerging Dance Styles	Which emerging dance style stood out to you and why?	What makes this dance style's contribution significant to the global dance scene?

- 1. How do contemporary and emerging music and arts in the Philippines and Southeast Asian countries reflect their cultural heritage?
- 2. How do contemporary and emerging music and arts from Southeast Asia contribute to the global cultural landscape?
- 3. What are the common themes and subjects found in contemporary music and arts of the Philippines and Southeast Asian countries?





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Activity 3: Pair Share

Materials Needed:

- Video link to the SEA Pop music and dance performance
- Worksheet with reflection questions

Instructions:

The teacher will review the basics of performing and visual arts.

Characteristics of Performing and Visual Arts

Subjects-This term refers to the main idea expressed in an artwork.

Theme-this refers to the learning focus of a particular discipline taught within a particular period.

Concept-is a visual representation that tells a story or conveys a certain look. It is commonly used in film and video games to convey a vision and set the tone for an entire game or movie.

Medium- This refers to any material used to create an artwork.

Techniques- This refers to the tools and methods used to bring about a desired outcome.

Processes-This refers to a series of actions, steps, and procedures taken in order to achieve a particular output
