Activity 4: Applying Key Concepts

Objective: To develop students' understanding of how to apply relevant concepts, processes, techniques, and practices in creating contemporary and emerging popular performing and visual arts.

Developing Understanding of the Key Idea/Stem

Teacher's Instructions:

- 1. Start by providing a short overview of the main ideas, procedures, methods, and behaviors covered in earlier sessions.
- 2. Divide the class into four groups. Every group will present the creative performance idea that includes the main concepts, methods, skills, and strategies talked about. They will clearly demonstrate the use of the main concepts and techniques in their performance.
- 3. The teacher will give the last instructions for every group presentation.

Activity 5: Understanding the Assessment Criteria

Teacher's Instructions for Discussing the Assessment Rubric





- 1. Display the assessment rubric on the board or distribute printed copies to each student.
- 2. Explain the purpose of the rubric: to provide clear criteria for evaluating their creative work presentations.
- 3. Go through each criterion in the rubric one by one. Provide a brief explanation and example for each criterion to ensure students understand what is expected.
- 4. Invite students to ask any questions they have about the rubric. Provide clarifications and examples to address their queries.
