

- 3. What are the things they saw?




Differentiating Common Nouns from Proper Nouns

Name the nouns mentioned in the dialogue.








Notes to the Teacher

Remember:

Nouns are names of persons, places, things, animals, or events. They may be classified as common or proper. ➤ Common nouns are common names of persons, places, things, animals, or events. They start with a small letter (unless they begin a sentence).

Examples are trees, cars, shoes, fruits, and mountain.

Proper nouns are specific names of persons, places, things, animals, or events. They always start with a capital letter.

Examples are Jean, Johannes, Lolo Ando, Mango Tree, Mr. Manaloto, Mrs. Manaloto and Clark Picnic Grounds.
